Day 2: Cape Town

Day Description

We transfer to Buffelsfontein Game Reserve, a private reserve where we have scouted an excluisve cycle route through the wilderness. We are met by our armed ranger and back-up vehicle, and after learning about the various fauna and flora in the reserve, we hop onto our trusty bikes and the adventure begins! We may get up close to a variety of antelope and plains game, including zebra, giraffe, oryx, wildebeest, kudu, eland, springbok and we can visit the cheetah and lion enclosures to marvel at these mighty cats! Not only does cycling ensure a more intimate experience, it allows us to get closer to nature than we ever expected and makes for amazing wildlife viewing! Alternatively: After a trip introduction and briefing we shuttle out to Khayelitsha Township on the outskirts of Cape Town. With an estimated 1.5 million inhabitants, Khayelitsha is South Africa's single largest township and means 'New Home' in the Xhosa language. We begin our tour at the Velokhaya BMX Oval and Life Cycling Academy which gives children from this community a chance to be engaged after school hours. After a quick introduction to the Velokhaya project and a chance to cycle the BMX track (if you dare!), we take to the roads with a local guide explaining the culture and customs of the community. We meander past local shebeens (pubs) and butcheries grilling meat alongside the street, with the opportunity to sample local delicacies such as sheep's head and home brewed beer.

Day 3: Cape Town

Day Description

Tandem paragliding instructional flights are a great way of getting into paragliding or just experiencing the joy of freeflight. Flights last anything from 10-30mins.
