

ATWS 2016 - ADVENTURE DAY ITINERARY

Venture north to the Knik River Valley and the beautifully situated Knik River Lodge, the basecamp for Alaska Glacier Tours.

Alaska is home to some of the largest glaciers on earth. Participants in this Day of Adventure get to explore this magical landscape by helicopter. Fly over ice towers and see gigantic icebergs tumble in a glacial lake. Hover in front of the deep blue icewall and land on a massive glacier. Unlike most glaciated areas, the Chugach Mountains offer abundant wildlife, including moose, mountain goats and bears. Fly back to the lodge for lunch made with fresh, local, organic ingredients at the Raven's Perch Restaurant.

Your next stop is the Dena'ina Athabascan village of Eklutna, the oldest inhabited location in the Anchorage Bowl. End your day at the Thunderbird Falls Trail, a gentle one-mile journey through a birch forest that ends at a viewing platform of a 200-foot waterfall.

Tour includes transportation, lunch, snacks and all equipment necessary to safely explore the glacier.

Trip departs Dena'ina Convention Center at 9:00 a.m. with an approximate return time of 5:30 p.m.
