### Día 1 / DAY1 (November 25<sup>th</sup>)

Pick up at airport

Transfer to Ciudad Valles

Dinner in Restaurant Hotel Quintamar

Overnight in Hotel Quintamar

### DAY 2 (November 26<sup>th</sup>)

-9:00 am We depart from Ciudad Valles

-10:00 am Pit stop where you will have the option to try the region's cinnamon bread with coffee. (Optional Consumption and at the tourist's expense)

-11:00 am Arrival to the magical town of Xilitla where we will visit the Surrealist Edward James Garden and we will tour its installations, all while the tour guide will tell us about the life of this eccentric character and the surrounding structures.

-3:00 pm Food in Xilitla, a charming town that houses some fancy architecture and the last American jungle. Located in a coffee growing area, this magical town has plenty of quality restaurants that will allow us to sample and enjoy the local food.

-4:30 pm Pit stop where you will have the opportunity to try the local artisanal ice cream, considered by most as the best in the region, they have a large variety of flavors that could conquer your taste buds. (Optional Consumption and at the tourist's expense)

-5:30 pm We will visit the Cave of the Swallow, considered the most spectacular in Mexico and the sixth deepest abysm in the world, with 512 meters of depth, of which 376 are freefall.

This is a great vertical hollowness of karstic origin, formed by water erosion during millions of years of molding the rock. This place is a natural refuge of many kinds of birds, namely the white collared swift, often mistaken by a swallow (hence the name of the cave) as well



as parrots, parakeets, and quilas.

-7:00 pm We will hike back to the vehicle for a snack and to return to Ciudad Valles.

-8:30 pm We arrive to Ciudad Valles

#### Day 3 (November 27<sup>th</sup>)

-9:00 am We depart from Ciudad Valles

-11:00 am Arrival to the river bank. The guide will provide us with the necessary team to perform the activity.

Presentation from our local guide about the place and instructions on rowing upstream in the Tampoan River in order to make it to the waterfall in a typical panga wooden canoe.

-11:45am We will appreciate the beautiful waterfall measuring 105 meters in height. The Tamul waterfall is the tallest waterfall in the state of San Luis Potosi.

-12:30 pm We will navigate the turquoise blue waters of the Tampoan River, one of the most scenic and clean in North America, where we will be able to swim part of the river to make it to the Water Cave or the sunken Huastec Cenote.

-1:00 pm We will get to know the water cave at the bank of the Tampoan River, a cave with 25 meters of depth where the water springs from and flows towards a waterfall and into the river.

-3:30 pm We will reach the embarking point at the shore and will head towards the restaurant.

-4:00 pm We will delight ourselves with a rich local meal cooked over a wood fire.

-6:00 pm We arrive to Ciudad Valles

-20:00 Dinner Hotel Quintamar

Overnight at Hotel Quintamar

#### Day 4 (November 28<sup>th</sup>)

-9:00 am We depart from Ciudad Valles.

-10:30 am Arrival to the Tamasopo town where we will go to the first location: Puente de Dios.

-10:45 am We will be arriving to the Puente de Dios site where the guide will provide us the adequate gear to swim in the river and will tell us about the place.

-1:00 pm Transfer to the Tamasopo Waterfalls where we will make a stop to learn about the process of some products derived from sugar cane; we will have the option to purchase some cane juice, cane syrup, and sugar, all processed naturally and without chemicals or preservatives. (Consumption is optional and at the expense of the tourist).

-1:30 pm We will visit the Tamasopo Waterfalls and we will swim in the ponds formed from the waterfall. We will be able to do some intrepid jumps at different heights.

-3:30 pm Food in the town center, we will enjoy some flavorful local dishes.

-4:30 pm Return to Ciudad Valles.

-5:30 pm We arrive to Ciudad Valles

-8:00 pm Dinner Hotel Quintamar

Packing List

What to bring

- Adjustable watersandals (no flip-flops) and/or sneakers (minimum 2 pairs because 1 pair is going to get wet) or watershoes, NO CROCS!
- Light shorts or trousers. NO JEANS!
- Shirts that preferably are NOT made of cotton. (Any other material dries faster)
- A hat for the sun, sunblock, mosquito repellent.
- Towel (not too big), toiletry kit
- flashlight/headlamp
- Camera (you CANNOT bring it during water activities unless it's waterproof)
- Small backpack (for your camera, personal items, etc.)
- Lycra tights are ideal for rafting to prevent the occasional scrapes
- Ensure that your luggage is as light as possible and mark your belongings
- If you wear glasses, make sure you won't lose them by attaching a necklace to them, remember, there are activities that require jumping into water. You can improvise a necklace with a shoelace. Bring one just in case
- Bring hairbands if you have long hair. Especially if you're going to do rappel
- Personal First Aid Kit. Our guides are certified in First Aid and we always bring a First Aid



Kit, however, for your own safety, we are not allowed to distribute medicine. For this reason we advise you to bring your own.

- Bring a complete set of dry clothes with you. One set will get completely wet.

#### Changes and Cancellations Policy

- 01

To guarantee the reservation a 20% deposit is required. No trip is considered reserved without this deposit.

- 02

Your reservation cost will be determined by the number of people that you indicate in writing, with the responsibility of canceling any people that will not attend within a minimum of 48 hours.

- 03

For reimbursements, a written notice of a minimum of 15 days previous to travel (for full reimbursement). The reimbursement will be made through the same channel that the deposit was made, as long as it was by transfer. Cash deposits will cause a retention of 16% of the tax for its reimbursemen.

- 04

If your cancelation notice is less than 15 days ahead, the deposit will not be refundable.

- 05

The deposit is transferable to another tourist, with a written notification of a minimum of 48 hours before the beginning of the trip for which you are contracted.

- 06

The deposit may remain guaranteed for 365 days after it is made, by giving us your changes within 48 hours, and in writing. A minimum of 1 month notification is required for changes to be made to scheduling during holiday weekends, or special holidays. On any other dates you may notify us 1 week ahead, and it is subject to availability.



- 07

Any deposit made for trips will not be refunded, if you do not present yourself on the day indicated on your registration questionnaire at our installations, or the location previously agreed upon in writing, at the time established, thereby losing any rights to reclaim, refunds, exchanges, or compensation.

- 08

In the case of total cancelation by our company, your deposit will be refunded.

- 09
